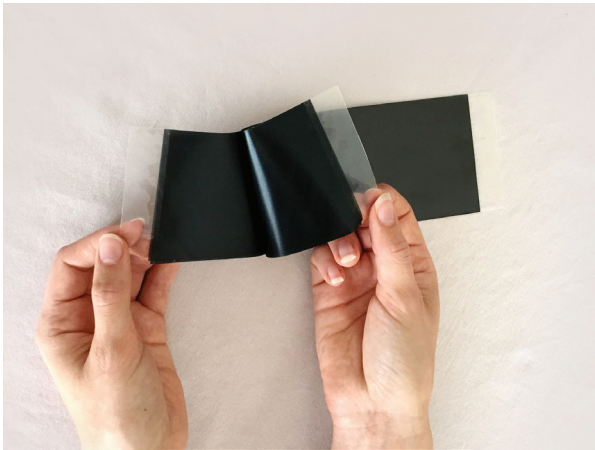


HOW TO TAKE A **FINGERPRINT**

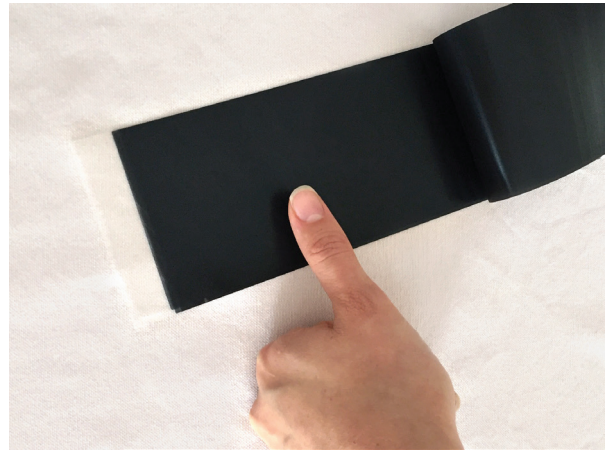

If you order a fingerprint jewel at Ines Bouwen, we will send ink foil by post which you can use to take a fingerprint yourself.



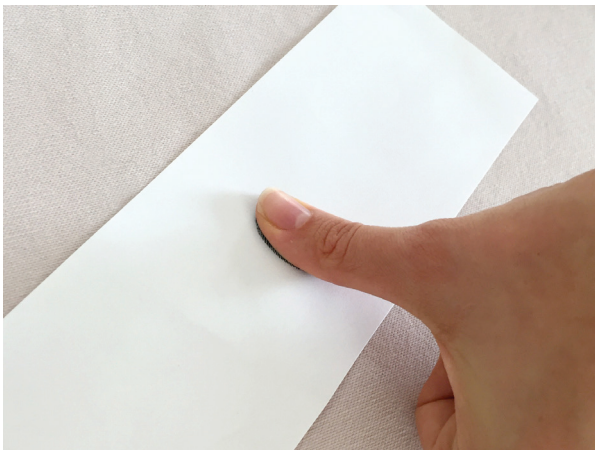
Step 1

Pull the white paper off the foil and pull the two black sheets apart so that the ink is exposed.



Step 2

Thoroughly clean and dry your fingers and place your fingertip on the ink foil.



Step 3

Then gently press your finger on a white sheet (don't press too firmly, as the print will become dark and smudged). You can try several times so that we can choose the best print, the lines must be clearly visible.



Step 4

Send your printout and your data back to us by post or make a scan in high resolution and send it to us via e-mail to shop@inesbouwen.com.
